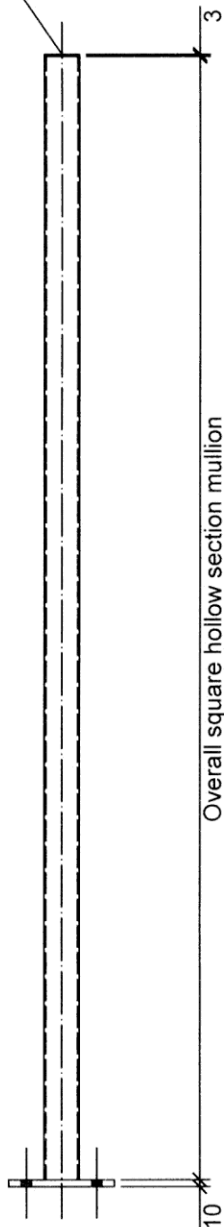


James Patrick Partnership Ltd. Partition Support Mullions

Cap for exposed mullions

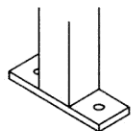


Mullions are widely used within the interiors industry to support runs of free standing partition where the head track cannot be fitted to a soffit or other structural member. The majority are generally manufactured from 50 x 50 square hollow section in a standard primer finish for building into the standard 50mm metal stud partition system, however they can be manufactured from other sizes to suit the partition system and the application for which it is being used.

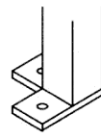
Greater stability can be achieved if the mullion baseplate is set at right angles to the run of the partition, however in a lot of cases this means that a part of the baseplate is exposed and, depending on the application, some action may be necessary to make the baseplate presentable. A simple way is to coat the baseplate in a painted or polyester powder coat finish, and use unobtrusive countersunk Liebig Anchors for fixing.

In the majority of cases the mullion is built into the partition therefore finish is generally not an issue, usually a standard primer finish is applied to give some level of protection against corrosion. In some cases however the mullion is exposed and in this case they can be manufactured with a painted or polyester powder coated finish to a standard RAL or BS4800 colour.

In the situation where the baseplate is built into the partition it is usual to manufacture with plain holes for fixing with standard through bolts. Care should be taken however if the mullion is to be fitted close to the edge of a slab, in this situation resin fixings should be specified as an alternative. If the baseplate is to be exposed then they can be supplied with countersunk holes for fixing with countersunk Liebig Anchors. This is in itself a neat, flush fixing but can be further enhanced by coating the head of the anchor to match the mullion finish.
